President's Message

The New York Bar Foundation celebrated its 60th year of operation during 2010, and we could not think of a better way to commemorate its history and legacy than by continuing what we do best—provide funding for charitable and educational projects that relate to the law and the legal profession. To that end, in addition to scholarships and fellowships for law students, the Foundation awarded 61 grants for law-related projects in 2010 in the aggregate of \$953,048.

As the Foundation's President, I have become increasingly aware of the thoughtfulness and generosity of lawyers and other Foundation donors. You continually demonstrate your strong desire to work together to change the world we care about and to help fix problems at the local and community level. You aspire to give opportunities for those less fortunate to have better and more fulfilling lives. Additionally, you wish for people to have a better understanding of the law and to realize how important it is to our society's well-being. More and more, people are turning to The New York Bar Foundation to help achieve our collective vision of providing access to justice for all, improving the justice system and the law, and enhancing the legal profession.

In spite of a sputtering economy, 2010 proved to be a successful year with several new Funds created within the Foundation. The Real Property Law Section contributed a gift to establish a scholarship for law students and named it in memory of the Section's former Chair, Lorraine Power Tharp. The Mark H. Alcott Fund was established to provide funding for *pro bono* legal services to the poor and the Trusts and Estates Law Section contributed a gift to establish a Fund that will provide fellowships for law school students.

We ended the year on a very positive note when in December residual funds from class action litigation, valued at more than \$850,000, was distributed to the Foundation.

We will use the funds to award grants for projects conducted by the University of Pennsylvania Law School's Center for Technology, Innovation and Competition and Syracuse University's Entrepreneurship Bootcamp for Veterans with Disabilities. We are pleased and proud that the Foundation can support these excellent programs.

Our Grant Making Program

During its 60th year of operation, The New York Bar Foundation continued to provide financial support for charitable and educational projects through our grant making program. The projects, conducted by legal services agencies, nonprofit organizations, bar associations and others are helping to meet the law-related needs of men, women and children of all ages throughout New York State.

The Foundation targets its grants to projects that serve the public and legal profession in four specific areas:

- *Enhance professional competence and ethics*
- *Facilitate the delivery of legal services*
- *Improve the justice system and the law*
- *Increase public understanding of the law*

A few of the programs we supported in 2010 are highlighted on the following pages.

Programs for our Children

Children – the most vulnerable in our communities – benefited from quite a few programs that received funding support from the Foundation in 2010. The programs are significant because they are helping children to stay in their homes, to receive educational benefits for which they are entitled, and to find shelter and nurturing in a safer environment.



One of the programs that received a Foundation grant in 2010 is the *Community Advocacy Team (CAT)* at the **Center for Family Representation (CFR)** in New York. During the first nine months in

2010, CFR served 1,283 clients with 1,903 children. With CFR's intervention, 1,318 children were kept out of foster care and 318 were able to leave foster care. Prevention of foster care placement is one of CFR's goals. Another goal is to ensure families achieve the stability to prevent foster care placement in the future and to discontinue the cycle of foster care for coming generations of the family.

CAT offers assistance of an attorney, social worker and parent advocate to parents who have directly experienced the child protective and foster care systems and have successfully reunified with their children. CAT is the only model of its kind in the nation and because of its success rate, dozens of community-based agencies refer families to it. Not only does the CAT staff work to shorten foster care stays at dramatic cost savings to New York State, it helps parents improve their chances of escaping poverty by making referrals to education, job training and financial literacy programs in addition to advocacy with the Housing Authority and Social Security Administration.

More than 50% of the children of CAT clients never enter foster care.

Programs for Domestic Violence Victims

The Foundation has provided financial support for many programs assisting victims of domestic violence. One of the organizations that received a grant in 2010 is **My Sisters' Place, Inc.** in White Plains. It conducts the *Special Litigation and Appeals Project* which provides advanced litigation support and appellate representation to victims of domestic violence in Westchester County and surrounding counties, including New York City. The goal is to help victims achieve safety and economic and emotional self-sufficiency through representation on matters including custody, visitation, child support, orders of protection and immigration.

My Sisters' Place receives approximately 40 inquiries each month from victims with potential appellate issues. Since January 2010, the Project has assisted 38 separate victims of domestic violence either through direct representation at the trial or appellate level or through advanced litigation support to staff attorneys who were providing direct representation.



Programs for the Elderly

The Foundation recognizes the importance of programs addressing the issue of elder abuse and, therefore, awarded a grant in 2010 to **Lifespan of Greater Rochester, Inc., Rochester** to convene an Elder Abuse Summit. The program, *The Prevalence of Elder Abuse in New York State Next Steps Project*, brought together experts from across the state to develop recommendations to address the growing problem of abuse of the elderly.

Nationally recognized authorities addressed several topics about the elderly including: aging trends, the Elder Justice Act and related policy issues, domestic violence in later life, financial exploitation of the elderly, and Adult Protective Services on a national level. Among several goals, the Summit's accomplishments included releasing the results of the *New York State Elder Abuse Prevalence Study*, the revision of the *Elder Abuse Action Agenda for New York State*, and ensuring New York remains a leader in all facets of elder abuse identification and prevention.

Programs for Tenants, Homeowners and Landlords

The Foundation funded several programs relating to housing issues in 2010 including mortgage foreclosure prevention and tenant record screening. We awarded grants in the aggregate of \$595,715 to **The Legal Aid Society, Legal Services NYC, City-Wide Task Force on Housing Court (now Housing Court Answers), Neighborhood Economic Development Advocacy Project** and the **New York State Bar Association** to conduct tenant screening and awareness programs for tenants, landlords and attorneys.

During 2010, staff at Housing Court Answers operated a hotline and answered more than 14,000 calls from tenants and landlords seeking information about housing issues, including tenant record screening. Additionally, through the efforts of the Legal Aid Society and Legal Services, tenants are being assisted with understanding

the implications of their past court history, whether erroneous information can be expunged from the tenant screening reports and how this may affect their future credit and ability to rent.

The education initiative stems from a \$1.2 million settlement approved in 2009 in a 2004 class action case, *White v. First Advantage SafeRent, Inc.* (04 CV 01611). The settlement funds were distributed to the Foundation to provide funding over a two-year period through its grant making program for tenant screening and awareness programs.



Programs for Teachers and Students

One of the Foundation's goals is to increase public understanding of the law. To reach this objective, we provide funding for quite a few projects that are bringing about greater knowledge of the law to teachers and students alike. Students of all ages from elementary and high school to law school have the opportunity to learn about the law from some of the programs we support.

Two programs that received Foundation grants in 2010 were conducted by the **Law, Youth & Citizenship Program of the New York State Bar Association**. Over 100 educators from the metropolitan and Long Island areas attended the *Law-Related Education Summer Institute* conducted in partnership with Project P.A.T.C.H., the Law-Related Education Program of the Northport-East Northport U.F.S.D. and the Center for Civic Education. They were provided with professional development to empower them to effectively implement and utilize best practices in law-related and civic education with their students in Kindergarten through 12th Grade.

Additionally, the State Bar's Law Youth & Citizenship Program conducted its *Mock Trial Summer Institute* again in 2010. Students worked with seasoned mock trial teacher coaches and attorney advi-

sors on opening statements, direct and cross examination, closing arguments, object, and rules of evidence. The 29 student attendees represented 24 unique high schools and were charged with the task of passing on to their Mock Trial teammates the knowledge gained through the Institute experience.
